

During the Spring Term, Year 1 will be covering a variety of topics and subjects. Under the curriculum tab on our school's website there are detailed maps of the Maths, RE and PSHE curriculums. There are also documents that outline the objectives to be covered for each year group in English, Computing and all other subject including Science, Art, and Geography etc (called curriculum coverage objectives). Below staff have outlined what topics or units they will be covering to fulfil these areas of curriculum. The specific objectives are not listed as they may change or be targeted at different levels during the year.

English

- Labels and captions
- Story sequencing
- Story writing
- Recounts
- Non-chronological reports

We will be doing this by having a 'book of the week' which will be different traditional tale each week.

Maths

- Measurement - Money, capacity and volume, mass and weight.
- Fractions (1/2 and 1/4)

Computing

- Programming and basic computer skills

Science

- Weather, seasonal change and materials.

Topics

Spring 1 - Traditional tales

Running alongside our English subject will be traditional tales. We will be looking at these stories in detail. We will be doing lots of Art, DT and Science base activities based around the stories.

Spring 2 - Our environment

In this topic we will be exploring plants and growing things, looking and plant cycles and food chains. We will also be looking at the seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK. Beginning to understand the hot and cold areas of the world.

In this half term, we will also be returning to seasonal change with a Winter and Spring focus.
