

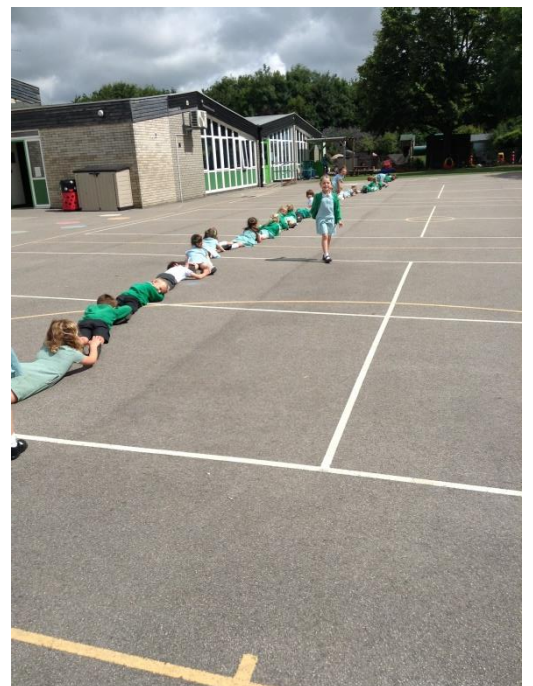
Summer term
