Below staff have outlined what topics or units they will be covering to fulfil these areas of curriculum. The specific objectives are not listed as they may change or be targeted at different levels during the year.

#### ***Summer 1 - Animals***

In this half term we will be learning how to classify different animals. Mammals, reptiles, birds, fish and amphibians. We will also be learning about which animals are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. This topic will be followed by a trip to Chester Zoo to see if we can apply what we have learnt in the zoo.

#### ***Spring 2 - The Queen***

In our final half term we will be doing book art based on The Queen. We will be looking at where she is The Queen of, timelines, royal celebrations and memories within and beyond our living memory. We will be having a royal tea party and celebrate a coronation in the classroom.
