Year 6 Spring Term Overview

During the Spring Term Year 6 will be covering a variety of topics and subjects. In our English lessons, we working on a variety of narrative and non-fiction texts with the objectives will be taken from the interim statements for our end of year expectations. We will also have a run of lessons focused on Grammar and reading questions (mainly the longer 3 mark questions) in preparation for SATs. We will also be continuing to read used a longer text after our SATs . In Maths, we will completing a range of topic as part of revision, mainly focused on fractions, and then we will try to use our maths in more practical and creative contexts. After SATs the mornings will be a topic based curriculum based on London, which will be enhanced by the class trip at the start of June. We will also have a range of events to mark the end of the children's time at St Michael's CE such as church services and performances. The afternoon session will be based around the topic of the Ancient Greeks.

Science - This term the children will focus mainly on Animals including humans. This will consist of looking at cardiovascular systems and other aspects of keeping healthy. They will also spend some time looking at habitats and planning a variety of scientific experiments.

Topic - Children will learn about Ancient Greece - a study of Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world. They will use drawing techniques to design a Greek vase and from their drawings sculpt one out of clay and paint it in the Greek Style. Also, they will research various styles of Ancient Greek architecture. Using a 3d drawing program the children will design a Greek temple.

P.E -The Olympics: Keeping with our Ancient Greek theme, the children will participate in a number of Olympic events. They will also be in training for our summer sports day.

Computing - Powerpoint (with sound) and Databases.

Music - Flute (taught by a specialist flute teacher

PSHE - Keeping safe. The children will be looking at the dangers found on social media and how they can keep themselves protected

Spanish - Children will continue to improve their knowledge of language and culture.

R.E - Pentecost and Ascension: The children will look at these two events and how they make Christianity distinctive. Our key focus is trust and faith
