Objectives

Outcomes

Art and Design

- Talk about and answer questions about the starting point, and choices they have made, e.g. chosen tools, media, materials.
- Show confidence in working creatively e.g. with a range of media on different scales.
- Develop and record their ideas through painting, drawing, sculpture in response to first hand observations, e.g. real objects, photographs, artefacts, and experiences.
- Begin to use drawing - look at different implements (pencils, pastels, felt tips) and the different effects that can be created including shading and cross-hatching,
- Begin to use painting - looking at developing texture by adding sand, adding glue.
- Talk about the techniques, materials and equipment used in their work and the work of others, e.g. 'I used a cotton bud to add dots'.
- Describe what they like about their own work and the work of others using appropriate language e.g. 'I like the way a fine tip brush is used to add detail'.
- Adapt and make changes to their work and the tools they use as it develops.
- Describe how they have changed and adapted their work for a specific purpose, e.g. use of specific tools to create more texture.

Children will

- Draw/ paint a picture of the Liverpool docks.
- Create their own SuperLambanana based on other products that were carried by ships to Liverpool.

History

- Choose parts of stories and other sources to show what they know about significant people and events.
- Recognise that their own lives are similar and / or different from the lives of people in the past.
- Use common words and phrases concerned with the passing of time.
- Develop awareness of places in their own locality- Liverpool Docks
- Ask and answer simple questions about the past through observing and handling a range of sources.
- Consider why things may change over time.
- Recognise some basic reasons why people in the past acted as they did.
- Talk about what / who was significant in simple historical accounts.
- Demonstrate simple historical concepts and events through drawing and writing.
- Ask and answer simple geographical questions when investigating the docks.
- Describe similarities, differences and patterns e.g. comparing their lives with those of children in Liverpool.

Children will

- Create an informative leaflet about the Docks in Liverpool- including what it was used for and why it was important.
