The children can wear their school PE kits, but please could you ensure they have appropriate footwear, trousers and a waterproof coat on these days.

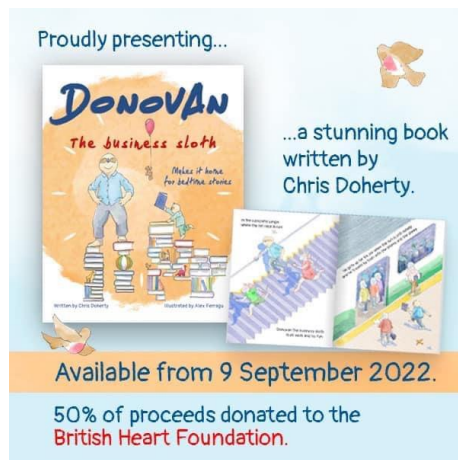
Our Majesty the Queen
